Tournament Rules

- Teams must consist of 4 members.
- Eye and ear protection required for all shooters and anyone assisting or pulling targets.
- Actions open on all carried guns at all times except when shooter is on station and ready to call for target(s).

- Bolts open on automatics and pumps and fixed breech shotguns will be broken open and empty.
 - Guns loaded only after shooter is on station.
 - Guns pointed in a "downrange" direction after loading.
- Guns unloaded before leaving the station.
- A gun may not be used that will accept more than one (1) gauge of shells at any time.
- Shot size no larger than 7 1/2 with standard velocity skeet and loads and "low power" only.
 - No shooter will be allowed on the skeet ranges after the intake of alcohol of any amount.
 - Spectators will remain at a safe distance behind the range when there is shooting in progress.
 - A "round" of skeet consists of 25 targets only.
