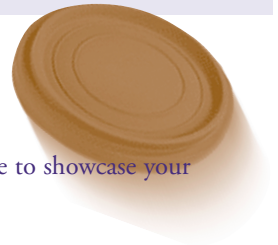

Tournament Rules & Driving Directions

- Teams must consist of 4 members. Let us know if you need additional team fulfillment.
- Eye and ear protection MUST be worn at all times while shooting or watching on the shooting range.

It is recommended that shooters provide their own eyewear (goggles or sunglasses) and ear protection (sound-minimizing ear plugs).

- Always keep your firearm UNLOADED, finger off the trigger and pointed in a safe, unobstructed direction until in a designated shooting station.
- All shells will be provided. Outside shells PROHIBITED.
