Dr. Jeyakumar trained at the Medical School at Meharry Medical College in Nashville, Tennessee. She completed her Otolaryngology residency at the University of Rochester, Rochester, New York and a Pediatric Otolaryngology fellowship at the Cleveland

Clinic Foundation, Cleveland, Ohio.

Dr. Jeyakumar is board certified by the American Academy of Otolaryngology. Dr. Jeyakumar brings expertise in the all areas of pediatric otolaryngology, particularly in the areas of pediatric otology, pediatric hearing loss and pediatric head and neck malignancies. She has numerous publications from her research activities, and numerous awards. Dr. Jeyakumar was the 2009 recipient for the faculty teaching award, a 2010 nominee for the St Luke's Faith Healer award, 2013 Honors award by the American Academy of Otolaryngology, and 2014 Scholars award by the American Academy of Otolaryngology.
