Dr. Yu is co-investigator on an NIH/NIDCR grant directed by Mairi Noverr, PhD, to study the role of *Candida albicans* biofilms in a novel rat model of denture stomatitis.

According to Dean Henry Gremillion, Dr. Yu was selected for this award "for her dedication to education at the pre-clinical, didactic, and clinic levels. Her work ethic and giving nature are complemented by her skills and knowledge, and her quiet confidence makes her an effective mentor to students."
